



## DATA PRIVACY NOTICE

The General Data Protection Regulations require organisations to provide appropriate protection for the personal information that they hold. TRUSTchildren Support Group UK has reviewed its arrangements for the storage of personal information about its supporters.

Under the regulations TRUSTchildren Support Group has a “legitimate interest” to hold data to enable it to communicate with its supporters and to comply with the law – for example to meet our obligations as a Charity and in respect of GiftAided donations.

We will hold names, addresses, email addresses and telephone numbers given to us by supporters and must hold details of donations but will not seek or hold other personal information about, for example, religious belief or political affiliation.

We need to hold data for:

- Trustees
- Donors
- Volunteers and visitors to TRUST
- Recipients of our occasional email newsletter
- Other interested parties who, from time to time, ask about the work of TRUST

Data is and will be stored electronically on the personal computers of officers of TRUSTchildren Support Group, principally that of the Treasurer, on the server providing the website and mailing list and on the servers of the organisations processing donations made by card.

We will not pass on the data to any third party which is not involved in the work of TRUST or of TRUSTchildren Support Group. We will use the data to communicate news and information to our supporters, to process donations and to meet legal obligations.

We will only keep your data as long as we need it to discharge our obligations as a charity, including data supporting GiftAid donations, or while you remain interested in the work of TRUST and TRUSTchildren Support Group and unless you withdraw your consent for us to hold it.
